

MAGSA PLAYER AND PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

MAGSA expects players and parents to behave in a sportsmanlike manner. The following list represents a limited set of guidelines for conduct.

PLAYER

- I will be respectful and courteous to umpires, coaches, players, parents and fans;
- I will not taunt, ridicule or argue with any umpire, coach, player, parent or fan;
- I will not use abusive or vulgar language;
- I will not engage in disruptive or inappropriate behavior;
- I will not hurt or attempt to hurt any other person;
- I will not throw my bat, batting helmet or any other piece of equipment.
- I will wear my full uniform (visor, uniform shirt, uniform pants, maroon socks) for all games; with my uniform shirt tucked in.

PARENT

- I will be respectful and courteous to umpires, coaches, players, parents and fans;
- I will not taunt, ridicule or argue with any umpire, player, coach, parent or fan;
- I will not engage in any disruptive or inappropriate behavior;
- I will not engage in or encourage any conduct that endangers others;
- I will not drink alcoholic beverages at games or practices;
- If I have concerns about a decision the coach makes, I will speak to the coach off the field, after practice or a game.
- I will communicate any coaching concerns to the MAGSA website which will be brought to the MAGSA Board.

MAGSA CODE OF CONDUCT SANCTIONS

- If, in the sole judgment of a coach, umpire or league official, an individual violates any provision of the MAGSA Code of Conduct, the coach, umpire or league official may issue a warning.
- If an individual receives a warning and then commits a second violation in the same game or practice, the coach, umpire or league official will eject the individual from the game or practice.
- If a player is ejected from a game or practice, he or she will not be allowed to attend their next scheduled MAGSA game.
- If a player is ejected from a game a second time, he or she will be expelled from the MAGSA program and barred from attending any further games.
- If a parent is ejected from a game or practice a second time, he or she will not be allowed to return for the season.

REVIEW

If an umpire or coach reports any violation of the Code of Conduct, the MAGSA Board will review the relevant facts and determine whether any further action (including sanctions) is appropriate.

ACCEPTANCE

As a **MAGSA Player**, I affirm that I have read, understand and agree to comply with the MAGSA Code of Conduct, including the guidelines summarized above. I understand my responsibilities and what may happen to me if I do not comply with the Code of Conduct.

As a **MAGSA Parent/Guardian**, I affirm that I have read, understand and agree to comply with the MAGSA Code of Conduct. I understand that the failure to comply with any provision of the Code of Conduct may lead to disciplinary action, including suspensions or expulsion from the program.
